The first step in tree identification is knowing that there are always distinguishing characteristics that separate one tree species from another. By examining different tree parts, you will be able to confidently identify the different trees around your community. This will require some detective work on your part; some clues that you will examine include tree type and form, leaf arrangement, bark and twig features and fruiting bodies.

DIRECTIONS from I-75:

Take exit 101 and travel south on Collier Blvd for 3-1/2 miles. Turn right onto Rattlesnake Hammock Rd and travel 4 miles, following the curve in the road as it turns into Thomasson Dr. Continue on Thomasson Dr for 1-1/2 miles and then turn left onto Bayshore Dr. After 1/10 mile, turn right into the parking lot. DIRECTIONS from Tampa (from the north) on I-275:

From I-275 take exit 31 onto Ulmerton Rd and continue for 10-1/2 miles. Turn left onto 122 Ave N and cross 125th St to pull into the extension office parking lot. There is more parking by turning left onto 125th St and driving to the rear of the extension office.

DIRECTIONS from St. Petersburg (from the south) on I-275:

From I-275 take exit 30 onto Roosevelt Blvd N/686 W and travel NW for 1 mile staying in the left 2 lanes. Merge left onto Ulmerton Rd/688 W and travel 8 miles. Turn left onto 122 Ave N and cross 125th St to pull into the extension office parking lot. There is more parking by turning left onto 125th St and driving to the rear of the extension office.
