DIRECTIONS:

FROM TAMPA (from the north) on I-275:
From I-275 take exit 31 onto Ulmerton Rd and continue for 10-1/2 miles. Turn left onto 122 Ave N and cross 125th St to pull into the extension office parking lot. There is more parking by turning left onto 125th St and driving to the rear of the extension office.

FROM ST. PETERSBURG (from the south) on I-275:
From I-275 take exit 30 onto Roosevelt Blvd N/686 W and travel NW for 1 mile staying in the left 2 lanes. Merge left onto Ulmerton Rd/688 W and travel 8 miles. Turn left onto 122 Ave N and cross 125th St to pull into the extension office parking lot. There is more parking by turning left onto 125th St and driving to the rear of the extension office.

SPEAKERS

Norm Easey received his bachelor's degree in Forestry/Resource Management in 1980 from the University of Wisconsin. He has been an active member of ISA for 26 years and is currently the Executive Director of the Florida Chapter ISA. He also has a part-time urban forestry consulting practice. He was the Forestry Manager for Sarasota County, Florida for 18 years.

Lynn P. Griffith Jr. is president of *Lynn Griffith - Tropical Plant and Soil Expert*, a consulting firm located in Palm Beach County, FL. He provides consultation for thousands of clients throughout Florida, the Caribbean, Latin America, and others across the world. Lynn's education includes degrees in Biology and Chemistry from Duke University and Jacksonville University. He is the author of four books including *Tropical Foliage Plants: A Grower's Guide* and *Tropical Foliage Disorders* as well as many articles for trade journals.

Paul Mitola is an Environmental Specialist II with the Florida Dept. of Agriculture and Consumer Services. Paul has a strong background in commercial pest management. He has worked for several pest management companies, owned a pest management business, and served as a branch manager for York Distributors. He worked as a pest manager for the University of Florida on a research farm, main campus, and two hospitals. Paul has served the State of Florida in his current position since 2003. He strives to educate the industry to help them avoid liabilities and litigation, and at the same time help consumers get what they pay for and protect them from illegal operators.

Dr. Jason Smith is associate professor of forest pathology in the School of Forest Resources and Conservation at the University of Florida. Jason conducts research and extension programs on diseases of trees and forest health. His research includes disease diagnosis, biology/epidemiology and developing disease-resistant trees. Before coming to Florida in 2006, Jason was a postdoctoral research associate in the Department of Plant Pathology at the University of Minnesota.

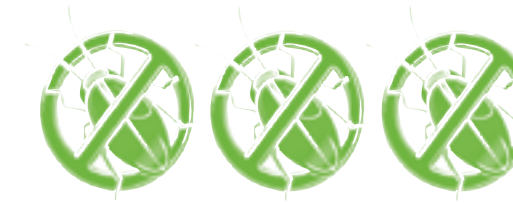
